

ROYAL ENFIELD REGISTERS SALES OF 86,978 FOR SEPTEMBER 2024

New Delhi: October 1, 2024: Royal Enfield posted sales of **86,9786** motorcycles in the month of September 2024 as against **78,580** motorcycles sold during the same month in the previous financial year registering **11%** growth over the same period last year. Royal Enfield exported **7,652** motorcycles during the month as compared to **4,319** motorcycles in September 2023.

Speaking about the performance for the month of September 2024, **B Govindarajan**, **CEO**, **Royal Enfield** said, "We have registered steady growth in the month of September owing to our recent launches.
