

ROYAL ENFIELD RECORDS SALE OF 74,746 MOTORCYCLES IN JANUARY 2023

New Delhi: February 1, 2023: Royal Enfield posted sales of **74,746** motorcycles in the month of January 2023 as against **58,838** motorcycles sold during the same month in the previous financial year. Royal Enfield exported **7,044** motorcycles during the month as compared to **9,112** during the same period last year.

Speaking about the performance for the month of January 2023, **B Govindarajan, CEO, Royal Enfield** said, "We have begun the new year with encouraging performance in both domestic and international markets. Super Meteor 650, our most awaited cruiser, which was launched last month across India and Europe has received exceptional response and initial bookings have been promising."

Royal Enfield launched the new Super Meteor 650 across India and Europe, as the brand announced retail availability and price of the motorcycle. Built as two distinct variants - Super Meteor 650 and the Super Meteor 650 Tourer - and in seven distinct colourways, the new Super Meteor 650 is available starting at INR 3,48,900/- (ex-showroom, India), at GBP 6,799 (OTR, the UK), and at €7,890 (MSRP, France).
