The versatile adventure-touring motorcycle will now be available in **Glacier Blue**, **Sleet Black** and **Dune Brown**, in addition to the existing colorways Gravel Grey, Pine Green and Granite Black. Showcased at Rider Mania 2022, the new Himalayan will also feature a USB port and debossed logo on grill and side panels.

Commenting on the new colorways, **B Govindarajan**, **Chief Executive Officer**, **Royal Enfield** said "The originally developed 2016 Royal Enfield Himalayan was a category-first, versatile and accessible motorcycle, which opened up a whole new category within global adventure touring.
