The Nirvik V2 also comes with '500D heavy-duty Nylon' fabric for added durability and the 'Superflow 3D AirMesh' enables improved ventilation ideal for long rides.

The jacket also includes 610D CORDURA patches at high-wear areas, reflective elements for increased visibility, and practical features such as a standalone high-visibility rain jacket, ID and medical non-tearable waterproof card pocket, genuine YKK front zippers, and TruDry waterproof pockets.

Whether its riding through the scorching summer sun, chilly winds, or unpredictable rains, the Nirvik V2 remains steadfast, providing optimal ventilation and insulation. Its rugged construction accommodates the rigors of off-road adventures and urban commutes alike, emerging as the ultimate choice for any environment.
