

ROYAL ENFIELD RECORDS SALE OF 80,251 MOTORCYCLES IN NOVEMBER 2023

New Delhi, 01 December 2023: Royal Enfield recorded sales of **80,251** motorcycles in the month of November 2023 as against **70,766** motorcycles sold during the same period in the previous financial year, registering a growth of **13%.**
