

ROYAL ENFIELD REGISTERS GROWTH - RECORDS SALE OF 70,766 MOTORCYCLES FOR NOVEMBER 2022

New Delhi: December 1, 2022: Royal Enfield posted sales of **70,766** motorcycles in the month of November 2022 as against **51,654** motorcycles sold during the same month in the previous financial year, registering a growth of **37%.** Royal Enfield exported **5,006** motorcycles during the month as compared to **6,824** during the same period last year.
